## Last Session Tomorrow at 5:00 p.m.

I will be doing a course on the sacrament of marriage in the Catholic Church. What constitutes the sacrament, its history, annulments and current developments. This is not a marriage preparation course, but is one that looks to answer questions such as:

- 1) Is it a sacrament if I marry a Non-Catholic?
- 2) Why did it take until the 11th century for the church to have the requirement that one be married in the church unless a dispensation was obtained?
- 3) Do two Protestants have a Sacramental marriage?
- 4) What is an annulment in the Catholic Church?
