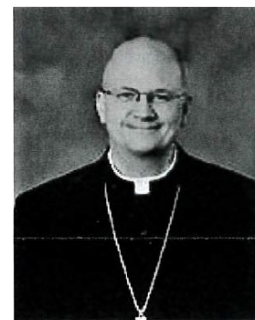

### The Sacred Voice Which Calls you the Beloved

Many of us struggle with not feeling we are enough. We have difficulty loving and accepting ourselves, which interferes with our relationship with ourselves, others, and God. When we don't love ourselves it is difficult to feel intimate with God or be in a healthy relationship with another person. In this retreat, we will discuss how the "liar, the deceiver" comes to "kill, steal, and destroy," and has a part in the negative thoughts we have about ourselves.
