Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I am writing this bulletin note before the March 5 First Confessions for our parish religious education children. Since Christmas, they have been working diligently to be ready for the Sacrament. Thank you RE teachers and parents for helping them learn about the abundance of God's mercy.

It was fun to give them the tour of the confessionals the other week. I answered questions about how some people sit face-to-face with the priest and others prefer to kneel behind the screen. There was some curiosity about

how the red and green lights work above the confessional door. We also trooped the classes over to see the two temporary confessionals in the parish hall classrooms. I explained that at this stage of the pandemic, we are giving people more air space. Penitents wait in chairs in the hall and confess in the classrooms at 4:15 p.m. on Saturdays. I told them we used the same portable kneelers with screens outside when COVID was worse. The message was that we should not let anything stop us from receiving God's pardon and peace.

I have been thinking about a question from one student as we walked between buildings. He asked, "What do you think about people when they go to confession?" I told him that when people confess their sins, I hear that they honestly want to be better disciples of Jesus. They would not be sorry, if they did not love God. I am sharing that with you today, because I wish I had shared it with the whole class. I hear Christian integrity in the sorrow for sins. And I pray that penitents hear God's desire for communion with them, when they hear the words of absolution. Pray that everyone, especially our young people, can grow through the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

announcing a collection to Aid Ukrainian Church:

...Collection to Aid the Church in Central and
Eastern Europe, which will allow the faithful to
make a timely contribution and provide assistance
to the victims of war in Ukraine, among many
other projects the Collection supports in the
region. If you do not or cannot take up the
Collection on March 2, I implore you to find a way
to give to the Collection by other means at this
critical time. The USCCB is uniquely positioned to
provide aid to the region, having built strong
relationships with our brother bishops there these
last 30 years, and having given so much assistance
in the development of the Church's capacity to
respond to pastoral and social needs. A robust
response at this moment will allow the Church in
the United States to continue to be a strong
partner in the rebuilding and restoring of the
Church in Central and Eastern Europe, and to give
critical and timely humanitarian aid now for
Ukraine. Let us ask Our Lady, Queen of Peace, to
bring a swift end to the violence

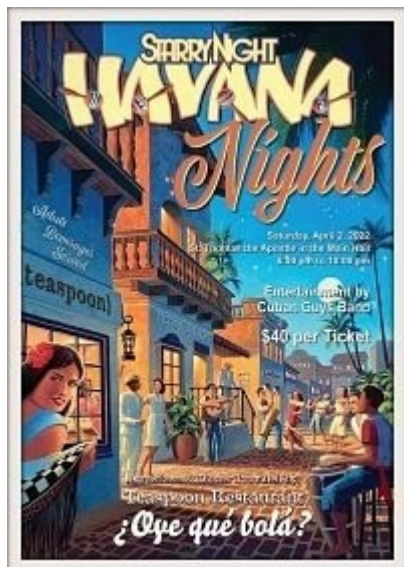

Ken Wolfe will facilitate our 2022 Lenten Teaching Series. It is a timely look at the stubborn theological problem of evil and suffering with the help of the classic ***The Problem of Pain**** by C.S. Lewis, (1940) HarperOne.

In the third century BC, Epicurus put the problem this way:

Is God willing to prevent evil, but not able? Then he is not omnipotent.

Is he able, but not willing? Then he is malevolent.

Is he both able and willing? Then whence cometh evil?

Is he neither able nor willing? Then why call him God?

We will explore whether this deepest of theological conundrums is solvable, while looking at collateral questions about the nature of the beautiful, the true, the good, love, and free-will tossed in for good measure.

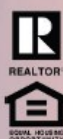
