The "Regina Caeli" is a traditional song during this season. Religious sisters and brothers, bishops, priests, and deacons offer this prayer as part of night prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours. Consider making it part of your daily

prayer. In these weeks through the Ascension and Pentecost it could be a special spiritual practice for you and your family.




