I hope you are enjoying the Easter season. The Church cannot simply celebrate the Resurrection on one day. It takes weeks of meditating on the Bible readings and singing Easter songs. This year, Pentecost is observed on June 5 as we end the season.

The “Regina Caeli” is a traditional song during this season. Religious sisters and brothers, bishops, priests, and deacons offer this prayer as part of night prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours. Consider making it part of your daily prayer. In these weeks through the Ascension and Pentecost it could be a special spiritual practice for you and your family.

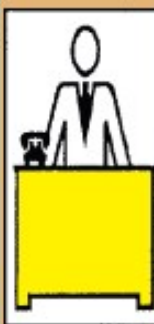
