

## January 26, 2025 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

There are a couple dates coming up on the Catholic calendar, the Presentation and St. Blaise Day.

February 2 is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Forty days after Jesus' birth, Mary and Joseph present him in the temple [Luke 2:22] In

some countries, Catholics leave up their Nativity scenes till this date. Mexican families often host a party on this day. In France, it is a day to serve crepes. The round shape and golden color of a crepe resembles the sun and represents the coming of Christ the Light of the World. Here, and in many countries, Catholics call Presentation Day "Candlemas." It also celebrates the world being filled with the light of Christ, represented in the light of candles. So, they bring candles to Mass to be blessed and used during the year.

At 7:25 a.m. on February 2, we will gather at the doors of the church to begin the 7:30 a.m. Mass with the blessing of candles. Please bring candles from home, if you would like them blessed.

St. Blaise Day is Monday, February 3. He was a bishop and martyr of the 4th Century. He is the patron for healthy throats. The report was made that while he was being taken into custody to be martyred, a mother brought her choking child to him. Although no one else had been able to dislodge the fish bone caught in his throat, St. Blaise prayed and the child was saved. So, his feast day is a traditional day for blessing throats. We will offer the St. Blaise Day blessings at the 8 a.m. Mass. "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."
