Dear Brothers and Sisters,

You may have heard by now that our bishop has been transferred. On February 11, Pope Francis named Edward Weisenburger archbishop of Detroit. He will be installed in the office on March 18. Until that date, he will serve here as administrator. We expect the Vatican to assign another

bishop or priest to be administrator until the Pope appoints the next bishop of Tucson. The process gives us continuity of leadership during an undetermined length of time.

It was nice to have Archbishop-elect Weisenburger here at St. Thomas last week for the World Day of the Sick Mass sponsored by the Order of Malta. It gave him the opportunity to personally thank our parish for actively collaborating in the work of the Church. The archbishop-elect served the diocese for eight years.

Bishops are successors of the Apostles. The local bishop is referred to as the Ordinary. The term refers to the ordinary power for the office holder's duty to govern the local church. The history of our bishops predates US statehood.




