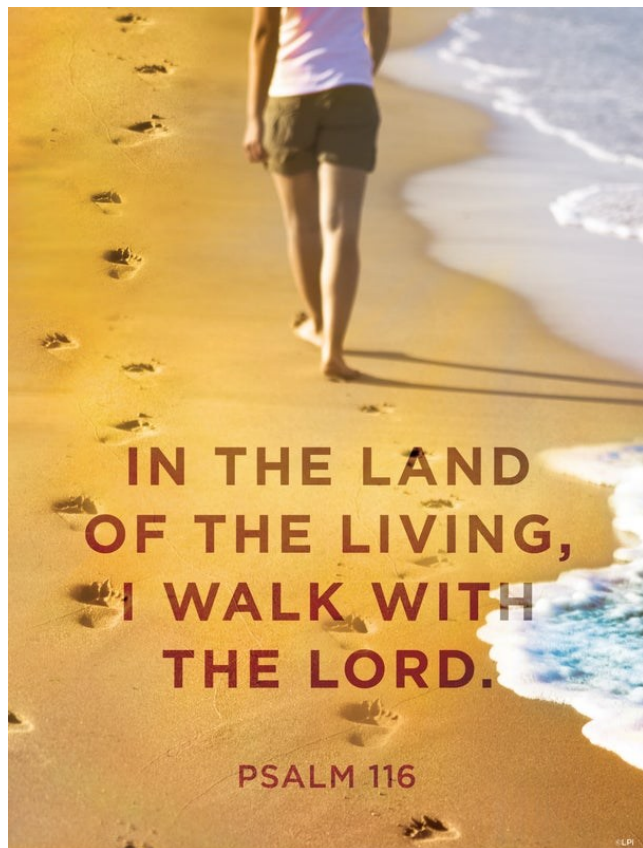

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

I would like to thank the Knights of Columbus for sponsoring the parish Saint Patrick's Day Dinner on Saturday. Good job! It is fun to enjoy a good meal together. Irish or not, we can celebrate the saint.

As soon as we put away the shamrocks after March 17, the Church honors Saint Joseph with a solemnity on Wednesday. His spiritual role is universal, not associated with one nation. That said, he is the patron saint of Poland and Canada. Italians have a tradition of hosting a "Saint Joseph's Table" feast for the needy. Plus, many Catholic countries use the March 19 solemnity as their Father's Day.

This week, let us honor the husband of Mary and the foster father of Jesus. Let us ask his intercession for fathers, workers, carpenters, husbands, persons living in exile, the sick and dying.

Last Spring, I made a pilgrimage to Saint Joseph's Oratory in Montreal, Canada. Here is a prayer from the basilica church:

 as you enfolded your newborn son.*

*Just as Mary and Jesus recognize in you the protection of the Father,

Help us to be lights in the world

so that the family of God

may spring forth from humanity transfigured in Christ.

Grant us the patience to imitate God's preference for the poor and weak.

Guide us in our pastoral activities

that our actions may be modeled on the Good News.

Dear St. Thomas Parishioners:

This past year (2024) has seen another increase in requests for **St. Vincent de Paul (SVdP)** assistance. As such, our SVdP conference at St Thomas Parish was increasingly called upon to prevent evictions, avoid utility shut offs, and provide food/fuel vouchers in order to help people struggling to make ends meet.

I know that many of you are aware of our annual **Stuff the Truck event in the spring**, which provides much needed clothing, housewares, and furniture for the SVdP Thrift Stores, but the primary mission of our conference is to provide emergency assistance to the needy in our immediate area. We do so by sending a team of two Vincentians to make a home visit when a request for help is made in order to gain a full understanding of the client's situation and to provide a Christ-like means of making person-to-person contact.

With this in mind, I would like to provide a **recap of our expenditures for calendar year 2024** in comparison to 2023, 2022, and 2021.
