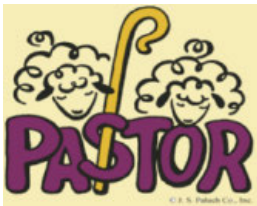

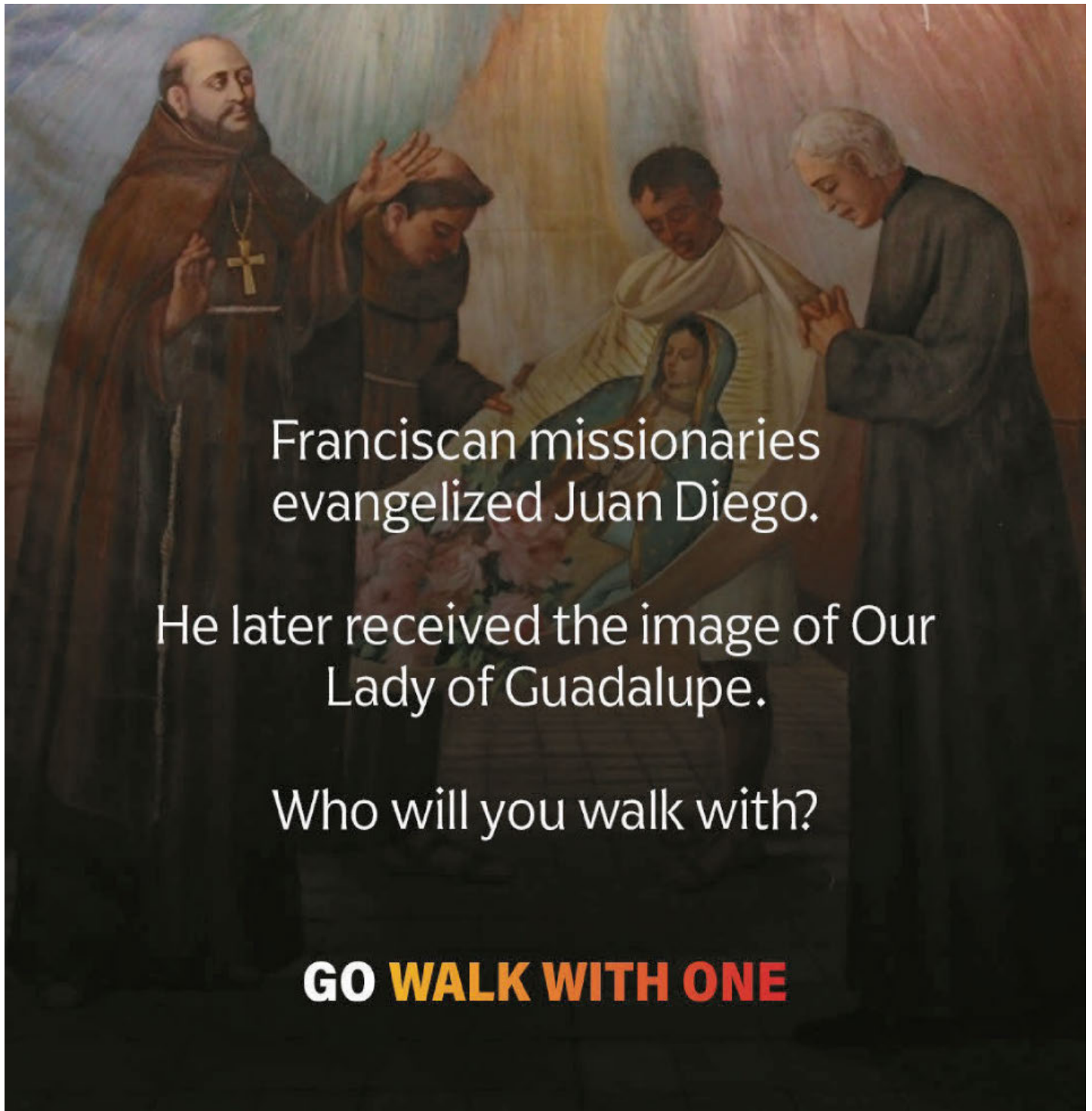
The **series of two classes** are offered on the 2nd and 4th Sundays of each month in the Chapel from 10:45 AM - 11:15 AM.
