

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The best storytellers know their material intimately. That is certainly true of Jesus. In today's Gospel the Lord tells us the parable of the Good Samaritan. It is clear that He is talking from personal experience — the experience of love of God and neighbor.

As the second Person of the Blessed Trinity, Jesus, the Father, and the Holy Spirit are love itself. And through His Incarnation, Jesus became our neighbor. Humanity is the man in the parable "who fell victim to robbers." Sin has injured the human race, and Jesus, the Divine Mercy, became neighbor to us and has rescued us.

Then, the passage loops back to the original question, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus' answer is: Be the Good Samaritan, "Go and do likewise." That is, love God and become a neighbor, showing mercy like the Samaritan. Oh, isn't it wonderful when that is our personal story?
