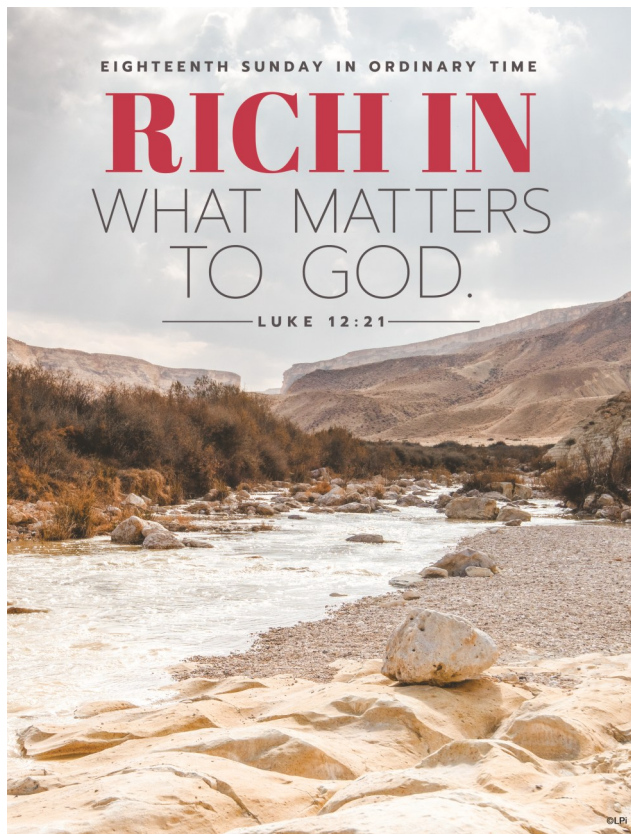

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Every week, the Church observes various feasts and saints days. This week gives us some great celebrations.

August 4: St. John Vianney, patron of priests.

August 5: Dedication of Saint Mary Major, Roman basilica.

August 6: The Transfiguration of our Lord.

August 7: St. Sixtus II, martyred with 4 deacons by Emperor Valarian in 258. St. Cajetan, Venetian cofounded a religious order 1524

August 8: St. Dominic, founder of the Order of Preachers in 13th Century

August 9: St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, martyr and co-patroness of Europe

I have chosen to share with you a brief summary of the heroically holy life of St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. (From the 2025 Ordo book)

Edith Stein was born in Breslau, Germany (now Wroclaw, Poland) in 1891 of Jewish parents. She studied philosophy under Husserl, the leading phenomenologist of his day. Inspired by the writings of St. Teresa of Avila, she was baptized January 1, 1922. She taught in various schools from 1923 to 1933 until forced to resign due to anti-Semitic legislation. In 1933, she entered the Discalced Carmelite convent in Cologne where she received the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. At the end of 1939, she moved to the convent in Echt, Holland, on account of the Nazi persecution of Jews, but in 1942, during the German occupation of Holland, she was arrested, transported to Poland, and killed (August 9) at the Nazi concentration camp at Auschwitz. Her writings include *Finite and Eternal Being: An Attempt to an Ascent to the Meaning of Being*; *Philosophy of Psychology and the Humanities*, and *The Science of the Cross*. Along with St. Catherine of Siena (April 29) and St. Bridget of Sweden (July 23), she was declared co-patroness of Europe by Pope St. John Paul II.

Rosary Repair - No Charge

If you have a broken rosary, we would like to help you. We are only fixing broken rosaries not rosaries that have missing parts.

You need to

- 1) Place your rosary and all the parts (all the beads, crucifix and center medal) in a zip lock bag
- 2) Include an index card with your name, clearly printed, phone number and the mass you attend
- 3) Place the zip lock bag in the box marked broken rosaries. Ask an usher if you can't find the box.

When your rosary is finished we will call you and you may pick up your rosary at the Religious Education office before your Sunday Mass.

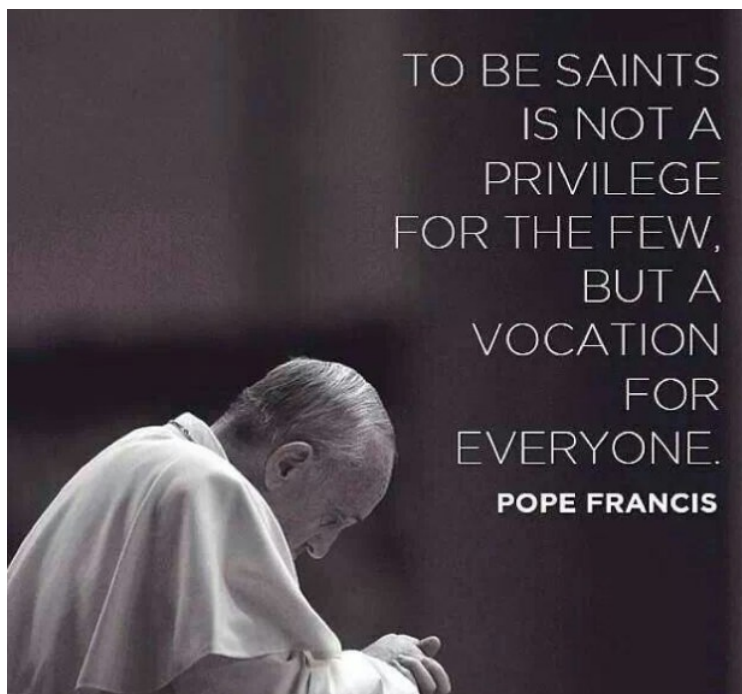
