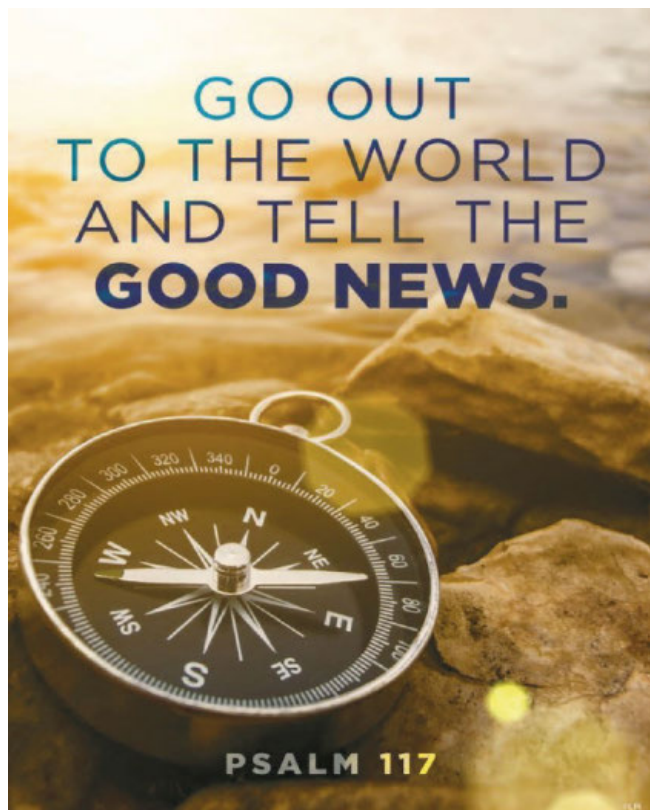

It may not be possible for all of us to attend his ordination Mass. Yet, it would be wonderful if we all offer a prayer for Carlos Nagore on this major step toward the priesthood. After his final year of seminary and deacon ministry, he will be ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Tucson next Spring.

In 1967, Pope Saint Paul VI reestablished the Order of Deacons as a permanent ministry, so now we have not only deacons on the way to priesthood but also permanent deacons like our own Joe Cruz and Ed Sheffer.

The three central dimensions of the diaconate ministry are: Servant of the Word, Servant of the Eucharistic Mystery, and Servant of the Charity of Christ. God bless all those whom God has called and will call to service in the Church.

We are recruiting new members to the prayer ministry for our beloved pastor and assistant pastor.

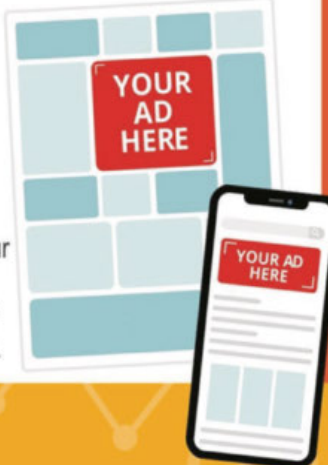

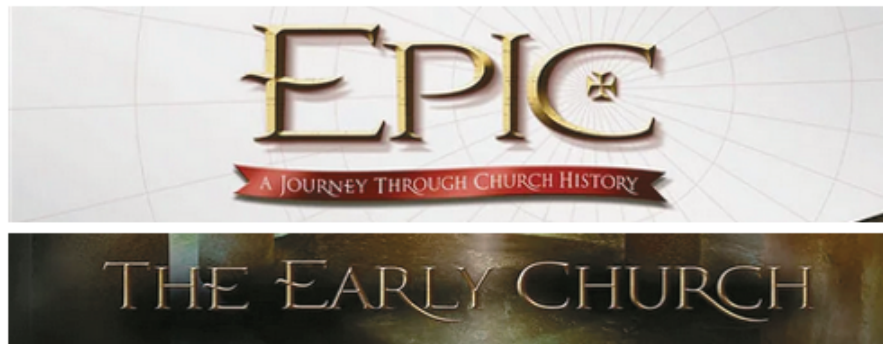

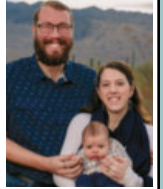
