

# September 14, 2025 Exaltation of the Holy Cross



Dear Brothers and Sisters,

#### The Exaltation of the Holy Cross

September 14 is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. This year, the date falls on a Sunday. It is nice for the whole parish community to participate in Mass on this feast. It allows us not only to honor Jesus Christ who gave his life on the Cross but also to celebrate the triumph of

Jesus over sin and death.

On this feast, St. Thomas the Apostle Parish is initiating a new prayer program that uses a traveling crucifix. Each week, one parishioner or parish family will host the Vocation Crucifix in their home. Each day, prayers are said for holy vocations: Monday for Married Life; Tuesday for Consecrated Single Life; Wednesday for Priesthood; Thursday for Consecrated Religious Life (sisters and brothers); Friday for Permanent Diaconate.

I would like to thank Deacon Ed Sheffer, Minnis Valenzuela Salmon, Rob Weierman, and their collaborators for organizing this program. I believe our prayerful support of vocations will strengthen families, our parish, and the Church.

### New Blessing at Mass for EM's of HC for the Homebound

Next weekend, you will see a new procedure for Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. At the end of Mass, the priest will bless those who carry Holy Communion to the homebound. These EM's of HC are caring spiritually for family members, friends, and parishioners who cannot participate in Mass because of advanced age or illness. It is a beautiful (and somewhat invisible) ministry. This new procedure is a more solemn way to entrust the Blessed Sacrament to each minister. Plus, this visible action will remind the congregation that we are united in Christ with all the Faithful, including these brothers and sisters who are separated from us because of their condition.





### **7-Sisters Ministry**

Seven Sisters Apostolate seeks to cover every priest in prayer. One Holy Hour, One Priest, Each Week, One Heart of Prayer. The Seven Sisters Apostolate consists of a core group of seven women praying a holy hour one day of the week (covering each day of the week). The simplicity of the apostolate is such that it requires no meetings or mandatory gatherings. The commitment is a generous offering until May 31, 2026, and with an opportunity to prayerfully discern to re-commit June 1, 2026, for a whole year. The soul of the apostolate is the "hidden" commitment of a weekly holy hour. The Seven Sisters Apostolate "is a call to strengthen the Church by ensuring that a Holy Hour is prayed each day of the week for the sole intention of a specific priest or bishop — a "holy wasting" (cf. Mt. 26:10) or lavishing of prayer for his deeper conformity to Christ."

We need 9 more Sisters to complete to this calling mission for our 3 individual Pastors/ Priests at St. Thomas.








# Ad Majorem Dei Gloriam

in conjunction with Seven Siscers Aposcolate

Fasting Brothers are men who commit to fasting one day a week in conjunction with their parish's Seven Sisters group (cf. NEARE: SevenSistersApostolate.org) exclusively for the intention of their pastor. Sunday is excluded as it is the Lord's day and thus unsuited to penance.

WHAT Fasting Brothers each commit to a day of the week (other than Sunday) to offer their fasts in union with the Eucharistic Holy WE DO: Hour of a Seven Sister for their priest. Each man chooses what type of fast he will offer, e.g. no food all day, only bread and water, not eating until 3 p.m.-whatever he discerns from the Holy Spirit. It should be sacrificial.

WHY On the specific day of the week to which he has committed, a Fasting Brother offers his fast solely for the intentions of the WE FAST: pastor. These include: the priest's sanctification in general, specific spiritual and temporal needs, and his ever-deepening devotion to Our Lady, Mother of Priests. These mirror the Seven Sisters' intentions during their Eucharistic Holy Hours. It is also encouraged that the Fasting Brothers offer their fasts for the priest's increased devotion to St. Joseph, model of fortitude and purity.

As an evangelizing parish that forms disciples through worship, formation and service, a key component is each individual's personal commitment to his/her own vocation.


