DUTIES OF THE CORPORATE BOARD TREASURER

1. Reviews and may oversee the coordination/maintenance of accurate and detailed accounting of all receipts and disbursement of Parish funds following the Parish Uniform Chart of Accounts for reporting operations of the Parish found in the Accounting Manual for Parishes in the Diocese of Tucson.
2. Reviews and may oversee the Parish property and casualty insurance coverage under the Diocesan Insurance Program.
3. Reviews and may oversee collection and accounting of Parish contributions (both restricted and non-restricted) and special collections.
4. Coordinates the punctual preparation of the annual Parish budget according to the Diocesan Parish budgeting guidelines.
5. Review and may oversee the preparation of financial reports to the Parish and to the Diocese.
6. May serve as an ex-officio member of the Finance Council or Finance Committee.
7. Is familiar with the Diocesan Accounting Manual as it applies to the parish financial viability.
8. Is familiar with the Diocesan Building Policy as it applies to the Parish's capital campaign projects and building projects.
9. Presents budgets and financial statements to the Board of Directors for approval.

- **Bio for nominee,** Jim Susa has been a St. Thomas parishioner since 2017. His parents have been parish members since the parish began while he was in high school. He is employed by the DeConcini law firm, and he works in tax law. He is licensed in Arizona as both a CPA and attorney. He has served on the parish finance council since 2020. He is a native Tucsonan and a graduate of Amphitheater High School. He also graduated from the University of Arizona Colleges of Business and Law, both with cum laude recognition. He also earned a second law degree from the University of Florida. He currently serves as Treasurer for the DeConcini law firm, the Skyline HOA, and Patronato San Xavier and has previously served as Treasurer for the Boy Scouts of America, Catalina Council. He is a widower with five children, all adults.

“My daughter is an only child, so she’s really depressed. We all are.”

-Felix, husband, father, parishioner, construction worker. Detained in Tucson and deported to Nogales, Sonora.

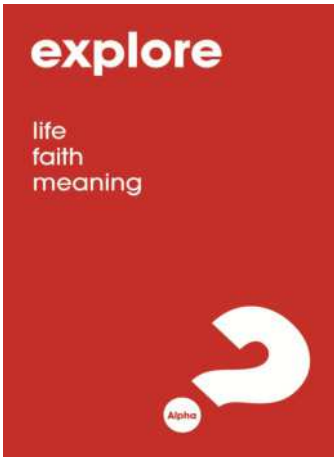
Felix was driving to work one morning, as he has done for 27 years in Tucson, when an ICE agent detained him. When he asked why they stopped him, Felix says the ICE agent would not respond but just kept asking for his ID. Felix had no criminal record. Within a week ICE deported him to Mexico.

“I’ve worked in construction all over Tucson. I easily laid concrete on more than 100 houses in the city,” Felix said. He and his wife are long-time parishioners of a Catholic parish, where they have many friends.

Felix is most worried about the impact of his deportation on his family. “My wife is going to have to self deport for us to be together, which is the most important thing. She doesn’t have any papers. My daughter lives in Phoenix and has DACA, so she won’t be able to leave the country to visit us. She’s an only child, so she’s really depressed. We all are.” Starting from scratch in Mexico, Felix says they don’t know what to do or what will happen. “Only God knows.”

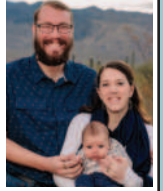

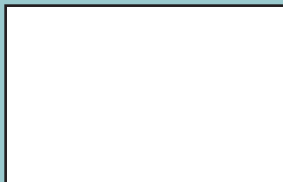

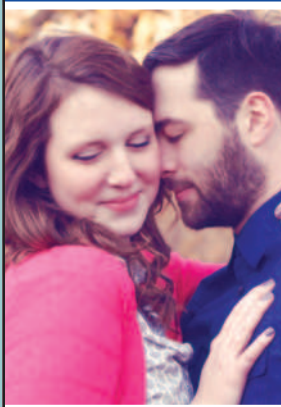
