Open Invitation - Walking with Moms in Need Meeting Thursday, May 7 1:00 PM Classroom #6

St. Thomas the Apostle's **Walking with Moms in Need** ministry is offering an **open invitation** to all interested St. Thomas parishioners to its May meeting. This meeting features guest speaker Sue Stallard, Interventional Services Manager at **Hands of Hope**.

Hands of Hope Tucson is a Christ-centered, faith-based non-profit organization. While it identifies as a religious organization, its services are offered to individuals regardless of their personal religious affiliation.

No RSVP required; just show up!

- **Mission:** Its stated mission is to be a Christ-centered organization that promotes a "culture of life, hope, and healing".
- **Volunteers:** The organization requires its volunteers to demonstrate a "passion for Jesus Christ".
- **Religious Practice:** Staff and volunteers may offer to pray with clients during sessions, though some clients have noted that they are not "pushy" about their faith.
- **Ecclesiastical Partnerships:** It collaborates frequently with local Christian institutions, such as the Oro Valley Church of the Nazarene and Casas Church, for community outreach and fundraising.
- **Core Beliefs and Values:** The organization operates under several faith-based convictions:
 - **Pro-Life Stance:** It promotes the "sanctity of life" and envisions a culture where human life is protected from "conception to natural death".
 - **Biblical Sexuality:** Its educational programs for youth and families teach "Biblical sexuality" and "sexual integrity".
 - **Abortion Recovery:** A significant part of its ministry involves offering "emotional and spiritual support" and paths to healing for those who have experienced abortion.
 - **Services Provided:** All medical and support services are offered free of charge.
 - **Pregnancy Services:** Lab-quality pregnancy testing and medically performed ultrasounds to confirm and date pregnancies.
 - **STI Care:** Testing and limited treatment for sexually transmitted infections.
 - **Counseling:** Options counseling (which does not include abortion referrals), specialized grief counseling for perinatal loss, and "Mending the Soul" faith-based abuse recovery.
 - **Material Support:** Provision of items like diapers, baby clothes, and furniture.

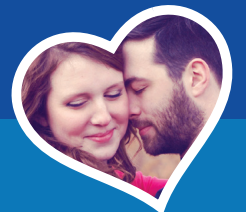

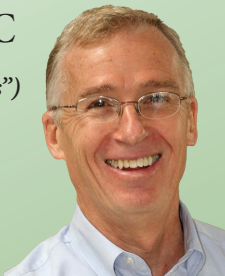
