





Dear Parishioners,

When I asked about the proposed change in Mass schedules in March, we received feedback from the parishioners. We had about 15 people from St. Mary say they would be happy to have Mass at 4:00 pm again. We had one person say that if we moved the Mass back to 4:00 pm that they would never come to St. Mary's again. The St. Barbara parishioners had about 20 people ask that the Mass not be moved to 6:00 pm. We also had about 5 people tells us that they would be happy to have the Mass at 6:00 pm, as they used to have Mass at that time prior to 2014. All totaled, the break down was about even.

Therefore, I moved ahead with asking permission to make the change to the Mass schedule. Our Regional Vicar, Fr. Frederick Cain, has approved the change in the Mass schedule that I suggested, and has given us permission to implement the change. The new Mass schedule will go into effect the weekend of September 7-8. That will mean that beginning the 7th of September, and every Saturday to follow the 4:00 pm Mass will be held at St. Mary church and the 6:00 pm Mass will take place at St. Barbara church. All of the other Mass times and places will remain the same.

I know that change is sometimes challenging, but it is a constant part of life. We are striving to be the best that we can be as a community as we prepare to become one parish in January. Please remember that we are trying to respond to the greater good of the entire grouping in order to provide Mass times that are accessible to as many people as possible, in order for us to continue to grow in Christ. With His assistance, we will continue to share the good news of salvation with those whom we encounter so as to build the Body of Christ.






