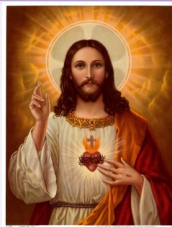

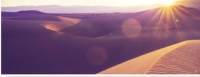

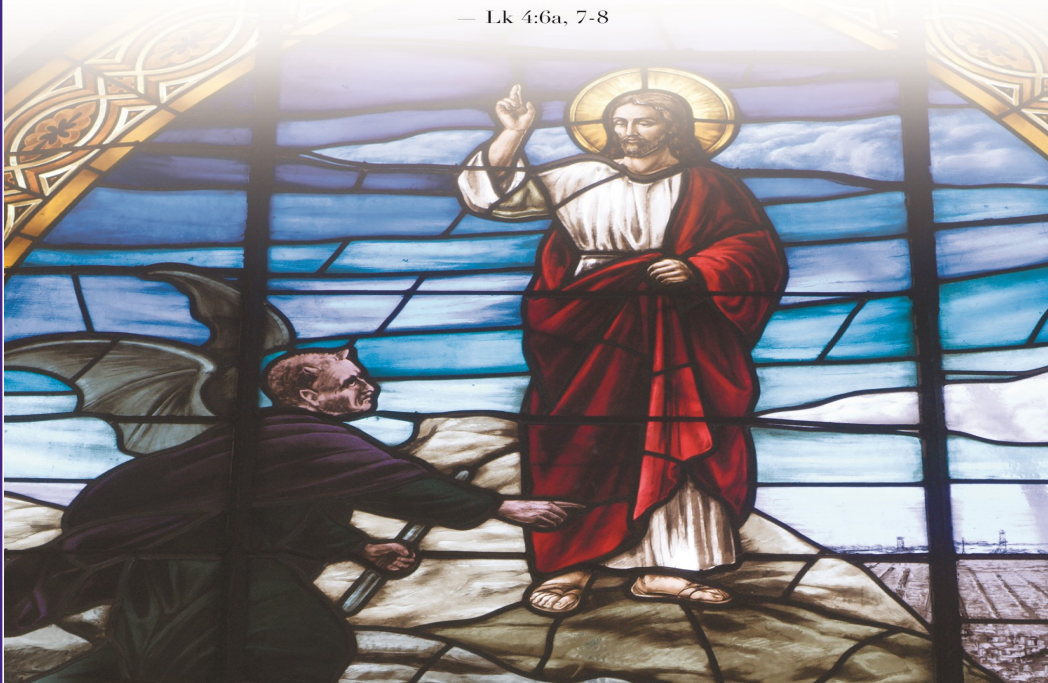

## From the Parochial Vicar



Our parish is offering a formation series on prayer this Lent that will help and encourage us to pray with Scripture. It will be excellent, and I encourage everyone to come. But if you cannot come to the parish series on lectio divina, here is another option for incorporating Scripture into your prayer life: learn to pray like a monk. For centuries, monks and nuns have gathered together several times each day to pray in community. The heart of their communal prayer is the Psalms, which might be called the Bible's prayer book.

The daily prayer of monks and nuns is called The Liturgy of the Hours, or the Divine Office. But it's not restricted to monks and nuns. Priests and deacons pray the main hours each day, as do many lay people. The staff at Sacred Heart gathers every morning to pray Morning Prayer. And although it is wonderful to pray together, many people also pray the Liturgy of the Hours in private. And you can, too. The book containing the Scripture passages and prayers for the Liturgy of the Hours is commonly called a breviary. Using a breviary can require some page flipping and marking, and a knowledge of the liturgical calendar. But thanks to the marvels of technology, you can begin praying the Divine Office without buying a breviary and without learning how to navigate a complicated liturgical book. All you need is our Sacred Heart parish app.

If you install the MyParish app on your phone or tablet and choose Sacred Heart as your home parish, you will find a button labeled Divine Office. It will give you the Divine Office texts for each day (the app loads several days at a time, so you might have to scroll a little to find the right day). Many people find it intimidating to simply begin reading the Divine Office by themselves. It was designed to be prayed with others, and most people learn this form of prayer as part of a community. But not to worry — the parish app also includes audio recordings of people praying the Divine Office together, so you can open up the day's texts, hit play, and pray along. Every community prays a little differently, but the recording gives you an idea how it works. And praying alongside other voices, even if they're recorded, reminds us that the Divine Office connects us to other people throughout the world.

The best way to dive into the Divine Office is to start praying either Morning Prayer or Evening Prayer consistently. Morning and Evening Prayer — also called Lauds and Vespers — are the two pivotal times of prayer in the Divine Office. Morning Prayer should be prayed around breakfast time, and Evening Prayer around dinner time. Once you're used to praying one, add the other. You'll be spending time with Scripture each day, and you'll be joining other people throughout the world lifting up prayers to God. Fr Patrick Grode

### Fast and Abstinence

We abstain from meat every Friday of Lent, Ash Wednesday, and Good Friday. This is for everyone 14 years and older. Every person age 18 to 60 must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting includes not eating between meals, eating one full meal, and two smaller meals. This would not apply if you have health issues. Let common sense guide you.
