



"What does it mean to follow Jesus Christ?

A question that we all have at various moments of our life of faith. I believe that Jesus Christ is Lord, the Savior of the world, but what does that mean? How do I follow Him? This is one of the main questions that retreatants on the 30 day Spiritual Exercises get to examine.





St. Ignatius proposes this question to them in a meditation called, "The Kingdom of Christ". In it, St. Ignatius has the retreatant consider an earthly ruler- we might think of a king or a coach or maybe a musician- who calls others to share in a great and daring project. The project itself is good and worthy- reform, victory, or beauty. But, even better is that the earthly ruler asks you to share with them in the experience. You will eat what they eat, sleep when they sleep, toil when they toil so that, just as you shared in the labors you might also share in the victory.

Would not everyone of right mind choose to follow such a ruler, a coach, a musician?

How much more should we not want to follow our Lord. He offers us the same. He offers us His food, His Bread from Heaven. He offers to toil with us-sharing in the sweat of our brows and the blood of our veins. He offers to go to the depths of toil- even to the point of death on a cross. All that we might share the victory with Him.




