From the Pastor

Here are a few points from my own presentation, "All Are Welcome."

People come to Sunday Mass from all sorts of moments in their life. Amazingly awesome moments and horribly difficult moments. I want our music to allow all to be welcome at Holy Mass. We make them welcome by finding music that allows them to bring whatever is happening and join it to the Altar of the Cross through the Holy Mass.

Sometimes we want "uplifting" music- understandably so- but "uplifting" can be very difficult for those in sorrow, sadness, or confusion. "Uplifting may make it so they think they aren't welcome at Mass in difficulty or sorrow. Our musicians see the need for this consideration in their music.

The Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ is the refuge for all in sorrow and sadness. By attentively choosing music that avoids dictating an emotion we can welcome to Sacred Heart both the sorrowing and joyful to find union with the whole Church at the Holy Mass. Whatever you're carrying, joy or sorrow or everything in between, you are welcome to bring it to the Lord Jesus, our refuge."



have access to a unique and powerful option to donate a portion of your crop or other commodities and direct your donation to ministries such as your parish, school or cemetery?

When an agricultural producer transfers legal ownership of grain or livestock to a 501(c)(3) charitable organization such as Sacred Heart Parish before the commodity is sold, the producer will not realize taxable income from a sale, thus minimizing taxes. The producer is still able to deduct the entire cost of the production of the commodity on the producer's Schedule F. Depending on the producer's specific circumstances; savings may be realized on federal and state income tax and selfemplovment tax.


