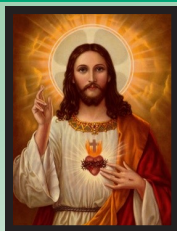

Dear Parishioners of Sacred Heart,



From the Parochial Vicar

My name is Fr. Jeffrey Schulte. Not only am I new to the parish, I am new to the priesthood as well. I have only been a priest for a little over a month now. I was ordained on May 28th. I am excited to be in the Aberdeen area. I grew up in Orient which is 10 miles south of Faulkton and 70 miles from Aberdeen which for me is a short drive home. My parents are Matt & Joann Schulte, I have one sister Jill Schatz and one brother Joseph Schulte. My parents raised us kids in Orient, my dad farms and ranches a mile north of town. I went to Faulkton school from K - 12th grade and I graduated from there in 2010. I went to college at SDSU and majored in Graphic Art & Design. During my time there I got involved in the Newman Center where I met Fr. Andrew for the first time. I became more active in my faith with bible studies, Focus, mission trips and just spending time at the Newman Center with other friends. Towards the end of my Junior year of college I started to discern the possible vocation to the priesthood. In the fall of my Senior year I met with the vocations director who was Fr. Paul Rutten at the time and began the application process to enter seminary. I placed my trust in God and said if you want me to be a priest then you have to get me into seminary and get me through all these years of education because I did not want to spend the next 6 year of my life in school. Providentially God fulfilled my cry for help and gave me the grace I needed to get me through seminary.

A little bit about my seminary journey. Since I had an undergraduate degree I entered the pre-theology program which is a two year program to meet the philosophy requirements. I ended up going out to Cromwell CT to Holy Apostles College and Seminary to do the two years of philosophy studies. I was there with Fr. Tom Hartman. After I completed the two year Pre-Theology program I continued my formation at Holy Apostles for another year in their Theology program. In the Spring semester of that year I discerned the Lord calling me to transfer seminaries, somewhere closer to home in the midwest. The Lord prompted in my heart to go to Kenrick Glennon Seminary in St. Louis. With the approval of Bishop Swain I started the application process to transfer to St. Louis. In the Fall of 2017 I moved to St. Louis to continue my formation and studies in Theology. I wasn't there all by myself, Fr. James Mason, a priest from our diocese, is the rector of Kenrick Glennon Seminary. Nate Allen joined me at Kenrick for a year and a half then discerned out of seminary this past Fall. I enjoyed my time at Kenrick and was appreciative of the formation they gave me. I feel confident and prepared for the priesthood but I still have lots to learn. Once again I am excited to be in Aberdeen and ministering to the parishes of Sacred Heart and St. Mary's.
