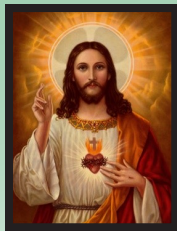

Why do you do what you do? One of my favorite movies is Indiana Jones and the Last Crusade. In the movie they are trying to find the "Holy Grail," the cup that Christ used at the Last Supper, to keep it out of the hands of the Nazis. In the movie, Henry Jones (*Sean Connery*), asks the question of his son, Indiana Jones (*Harrison Ford*), "Why do you seek the cup of Christ? Is it for His glory or for yours?" This scene has always stuck with me. It hit me a few years ago that this is a beautiful gut check for the spiritual life. Why do I do what I do in prayer? Why do I spend the time in prayer that I do? Why do I practice certain pious devotions? There were times, I wanted to be "seen" as holy and so I would go and make sure I told people I was going to go pray a holy hour. I would pray countless novenas and rosaries, not because I actually loved our Lord, but because I wanted to convince myself that I loved Him. Sometimes insecurities creep into our spiritual life and effect how we relate to our Lord. Do I trust that He loves me? Do I try to "earn" His love in prayer? At the end of the day, I want our Lord. I want to love Him above everything else in my life and I want others to know His love. I also know at times, I have mixed motives in prayer, and I try to "make God love me," by doing things, rather than being with Him in prayer. I invite you to spend some time asking our Lord to show you, your intentions in prayer. What are the walls you have built up there? Where are the places He is desiring for you to go deeper? Where are you going through the motions? Today, our Lord desires to purify your intentions, the "why you do what you do." When we seek to love God with all of our heart, mind, soul, and strength, each day, He will take care of the rest. -Fr. Tim

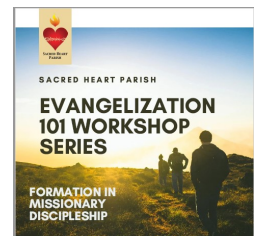
