

CEMETERY CORNER

We have been fielding a lot of questions about the cost of burials at Sacred Heart Cemetery. The Cemetery charges two basic fees, first the purchase of the burial right and secondly the fee to open and close the grave. Currently, we charge \$500 for the first burial right on a grave and an additional \$250 for the second burial right on that same grave. Open and close fees for a traditional full casket during the week are \$700, on the weekend they are \$1000. The open and close fees for cremations are \$350 during the week and \$500 on the weekend.
