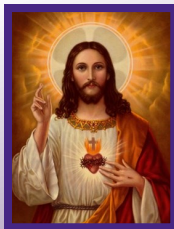

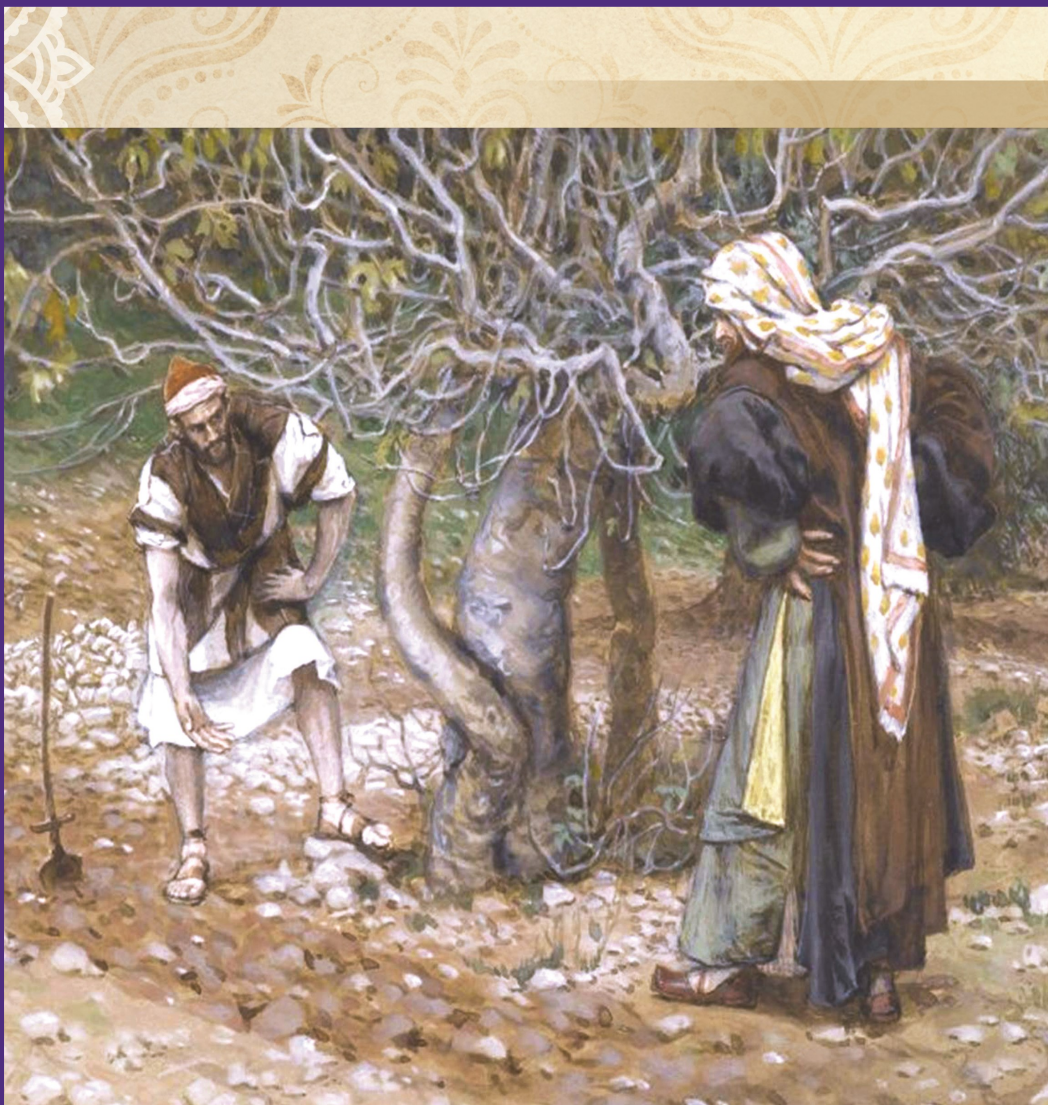

### Guest Speaker Jody Bottum at NSU - Mon., March 28th

Prof. Joseph Bottum will speak at NSU on March 28, 2022 at 7:00pm in the Centennial Rooms. The title of this talk is: "The Church of Christ Without Christ: The Religious Origins of Identity Politics." Drawing on his book, *An Anxious Age: The Post-Protestant Ethic and the Spirit of America*, Prof. Bottum will discuss the manner in which contemporary political debates regarding identity politics find their origins in certain religious ideas, with identity politics being essentially a religious phenomenon. Prof. Bottum, former editor of *First Things* and former literary editor of *The Weekly Standard*, is Professor of Philosophy at Dakota State University in Madison, South Dakota where he also directs the CLASSICS Institute. This event is open to the public and sponsored by the Center for Public History & Civic Engagement.
