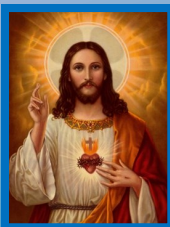

This coming weekend we have a rare event- the installation of a pastor by the Bishop. Why are we doing this and why now?



## From the Pastor

Why now is easier to answer, I suppose. This was when we could coordinate having Bishop DeGrood free to come up to our parishes over the weekend. He offered to do it in October- but the weekend was when the pastor (me!) was on vacation to run a 50k trail race. Alas. Then we tried December, but something fell through on his calendar. I am grateful for his presence.

Why are we doing this? I asked for this ritual back in March 2021 when this new assignment structure was announced for three reasons. First, I knew there were some uneasy minds that this 1 pastor for 2 parishes was going to be a "takeover" of one over another or a combination of some sort. I thought the ritual Mass of installation would emphasize that each parish remains unique.

Secondly, I wanted the grace and blessing of having our Bishop liturgically install me as pastor. This is a tough assignment and I need all the grace I can to fulfill these duties.

Finally, I wanted the chance for Bishop's aspirations for the parish communities to be expressed in this liturgical fashion. Bishop DeGrood's vision for the life of the faithful in South Dakota is inspiring and to have him come, not just for a confirmation or other event but just to speak from his heart about his desire for the parishes of Aberdeen to be a "stronghold of the north" in his Diocese.

I hope I can see you there. I know I can count on your prayers in our labors together. FAD
