This year the majority of our discussion was talking about the Set Ablaze initiative which is looking at the current reality of our diocese and looking ahead at a ten year projection of where we will be. I just want to say thank you for your support and sacrifice. We know it can be difficult when all the priests leave the parish for 4 days.
