Today we're offering Mass in honor of the Holy Apostle, St. Luke. St. Luke wrote the 3rd Gospel as well as the Acts of the Apostles, which documents the early Church's missionary beginnings- weak in earthly resources but powerful in the grace of Jesus. St. Luke is the patron saint of physicians- as well as the namesake of Avera St. Luke's hospital. We pray today for the healing of all who are ill and for all who serve the ill- that they would remember that Jesus is hidden within the suffering souls.



From the Pastor

Yet- what would St. Luke say about our culture that seeks to legalize marijuana? Marijuana is portrayed as many things by those who promote it: an aid for those who struggle, harmless fun and recreation, or even "none of your business, because what I do doesn't affect you." **Our Bishops are urging us to vote NO on IM 27 to legalize recreational marijuana (see the bulletin insert for more details).** Are they against healing? Are they against relaxation?

Their handout has good information, I would remind you of three things:

1. **Some people ask- what about alcohol?** I remind them that getting deliberately intoxicated is a mortal sin which we should confess as soon as possible. Whether that intoxication is alcohol, marijuana or some other source, we should confess. Alcohol, though, isn't on the ballot right now.
2. **Marijuana isn't like it used to be.** Some people "dabbled" with marijuana back in college. This marijuana is far different. It is specifically cultivated to be higher THC (hallucinogenic psychedelic component of marijuana). This is a greater difference than that between beer and everclear.
3. **Who will benefit from this legalization?** Some people claim the state will through tax revenue...Colorado bought that promise but has been disappointed. It has been estimated that for every \$1 Colorado earns on marijuana related taxes it has to spend \$4 more on the effects of marijuana (crime, 911 calls, etc.). Will we really cause a renewal of SD by granting unfettered access to a psychedelic drug?

St. Luke was a physician and in heaven he prays for our healing- body, mind, and soul. He would vote no on IM 27 and so should you, for the good of all souls in our state and Diocese. - FAD
