This week our society celebrates "Valentine's Day". This is loosely based on a true story about a real Catholic saint, named Valentine. What I remember from my own Catholic School education is that Saint Valentine was a priest of the early Church in Rome. He lived in the 3<sup>rd</sup> century A.D. or in the late 200's before Christianity in the

Roman empire was freed from persecution in the early 4<sup>th</sup> century by the Edict of Milan (313 A.D.) Saint Valentine was martyred for witnessing Christian marriages. Hence, he has been associated with the love proper to marriage between men and women. Unfortunately, Valentine's Day has been hijacked by Hallmark and good-old-fashion-American consumerism. At the risk of sounding like a grouchy priest, Valentine's Day has drifted far from the reality Saint Valentine represents, from virtue and nobility to self-gratification and indulgence in chocolate. Yet, I do not want to disparage celebration, far from it. As Catholic Christians we ought to celebrate with greater intensity as well as purpose. The purpose behind celebrating Saint Valentine's Day is his own great charity of martyrdom, he died for love of Christ our Lord. On top of fostering Christian marriages. The expression of this purpose ought to appear different from the unchristian society we inhabit. The Catholic Christian purpose of Saint Valentine's Day may be expressed by showing honor to loved ones, searching for their good qualities to affirm them, and other acts of selfless love. The materialism innately disposed in our culture ought not to be indulged, avoiding the emphasis on fancy chocolate and ornate cards. What are the gestures of charity that your loved ones need?

Coincidentally, the liturgical feast day on February 14<sup>th</sup> is for Saints Cyril and Methodius. There is not enough historical evidence for Saint Valentine himself, so his feast day has been superseded by Saints Cyril and Methodius who share the day. Cyril and Methodius are exemplary missionaries. They evangelized the Slavic nations, creating an alphabet of the Slavic spoken language to give them the Sacred Scriptures in written form. Saint Cyril and Saint Methodius are important intercessors for our unchristian, neo-pagan age. The Gospel of Jesus Christ ought to be preached and delivered to the world in ways that they understand. Cyril and Methodius were innovative in their approach of addressing the needs of the people they evangelized. How might we respond?




