

### HISTORY OF THE HYMN PART XX

### We Walk by Faith

Lyrics by Henry Alford, Music is the tune SHANTI by Marty Haugen



Although this piece was written with Saint Thomas and the events shared in this Sunday's gospel in mind, its opening words are from 2 Corinthians 5:7 - "[for] we walk by faith and not by sight," written by St. Paul. In this hymn, Henry Alford (1810 – 1871) echoes Paul and exhorts us to be true to our faith, and unlike Thomas, not require proof in order to believe in the Lord's Resurrection. In his original words (adapted by Haugen) Alford shares in the fourth verse his hope as a Christian:

That when our life of faith is done In realms of clearer light We may behold Thee as Thou art With full and endless sight <sup>1</sup>

Henry Alford was born in London on October 7, 1810. An only child who grew up without a mother (she passed away in childbirth), Alford had much time to absorb his father's influence and teachings as a rector of the Church of England. He attended Trinity College at Cambridge with high honors and became a Fellow. He became a vicar and a prolific writer of essays, poems and hymns. We Walk by Faith was first published in 1844 in a collection, *Psalms and Hymns*.

Among other hymns he wrote is a popular hymn at Thanksgiving, Come Ye Thankful People, Come. <sup>2</sup>

As shared in a previous hymn history, Marty Haugen (b.1950) is a prolific American pastoral musician. Among his many works are numerous pieces in our Gather 3 Hymnals.

May God grant us the gift of faith!

### CELEBRATION AND OUR JOURNEY FORWARD



Our scripture readings today and over the past week are full of joyous and awesome encounters with our risen Lord! We follow Jesus' words and the Angel's guidance: "He is going before you to Galilee; there you will see Him." Jesus' focus on Galilee is real, and it is also metaphorical for us who cannot travel back in time but want Jesus' presence in our lives as we move forward. We want Jesus here with us as He was in Galilee!

I was so moved by Pope Francis' homily at the Vigil Mass, regarding our own "Galilee" that I want to share it with you:

"Remember your own Galilee and walk towards it, for it is the "place" where you came to know Jesus personally, where He stopped being just another personage from a distant past,

but a living person; not some distant god but the God who is at your side, who more than anyone else knows you and loves you. Brother, sister remember Galilee, your Galilee, and your call. Remember the Word of God who at a precise moment spoke directly to you. Remember that powerful experience of the Spirit; that great joy of forgiveness experienced after that one confession; that intense and unforgettable moment of prayer; that light that was kindled within you and changed your life; that encounter, that pilgrimage .... Each of us knows where our Galilee is located. Each of us knows the place of his or her interior resurrection, that beginning and foundation, the place where things changed. We cannot leave this in the past; the Risen Lord invites us to return there to celebrate Easter. Remember your Galilee, Remind yourself" ----- Pope Francis

Today we are all invited to cherish and grow our own personal Galilee with our Risen Lord. Let this experience guide us to follow Jesus and grow in the Body of Christ together.

Today, Divine Mercy Sunday, we also stand witness to the Lord's proclamation to Saint Faustina. Jesus proclaimed to Sister Faustina that God's mercy is everywhere, and always triumphs over justice. Let us rejoice in this message!

Finally, during this time of Celebrating Christ's Resurrection and His all loving presence, we observe the apostle Thomas literally shouting from the rooftops his certainty of who Jesus is ---- "My Lord and my God." Let us recall our Galilee and nourish our relationship with "Our Lord and Our God!"

### ADULT FORMATION - THE CREED FINAL SESSION




