



In God We Trust! But How Much Do We?



Prior to 1956, "E Pluribus Unum" (out of many, one) was the official motto of the United States, today it is "In God We Trust." Further back in 1864, during the Antebellum period, Congress approved the use of "In God We Trust" on all one- and two-cent coins. Then in 1955 Congress mandated that ALL U.S. currency include "In God We Trust." So all of the currency we use today (except for crypto-currency I imagine?) have these words.

While most of us reading this do have some significant level of trust in God, I wonder, as a nation, how many of our inhabitants do? I would wager many people do not have much trust in God's providence (*God will provide*), and instead trust in their own personal abilities. This lack of trust is not unique to the United States, but our country has claimed otherwise as reflected on all of its money! If these words have any actual

meaning today, ironically it is the idolatry of money that is so pervasive in many parts of our society that run counter to this motto.

To be more reflective of today the motto might better be "In Private Property We Trust, In Modern Medicine We Trust, In Popular Opinion We Trust, In The Right To Choose We Trust, In The Bank Of America We Trust" but not "In God We Trust." Don't get me wrong, we live in a great country and I love this country, but we can work to make it better in the way we live and radiate Christ to others! As Christians we are all called to have that trust in God day-in and day-out as we live *in* the world, but not *of* the world. Peter trusted initially in today's Gospel, but that trust faltered and as a result he began to sink (literally!).

How often has our faith faltered when things in daily life are not going exactly our way and we start to sink in anxiety and despair? Do we turn to the Lord in full trust and in sincere prayer? God loves us and is always ready to lend a helping hand. Pope Francis once said that having total faith and trust in God means recognizing that he always knows and wants what is best for us, even if it is hard to accept because it might not align with our own plans. We are all human, like Peter, trusting and at times having doubts. I pray that especially during those times that are difficult, when things are not going exactly our way, or when we find ourselves outside of our comfort zone we can let go and let God! God is in control, He will provide!

May our all loving and merciful God bless you this day and every day.



The History of the Hymn Part XXVII

A MIGHTY FORTRESS IS OUR GOD

Lyrics by, and tune attributed to, Martin Luther (1483 – 1546)

In 1483 a son was born to a poor miner and his wife in Eisleben, Germany. An area well known for its music, its children would be raised with a firm foundation in that

art. Young Martin sang in a boy's choir, played the recorder (flute) and through the years became a composer of hymns. Luther believed and wrote that; "Next to the Word of God, the noble art of music is the greatest treasure in the world...A person who...does not regard music as a marvelous creation of God...does not deserve to be called a human being; he should be permitted to hear nothing but the braying of asses and the grunting of hogs." 2

At one time a Catholic priest, Luther later disagreed with the teachings and practices of the Church. The fervor surrounding his challenges led to his eventual excommunication. Although it is not known for certain, some ascribe his most remembered hymn to this event.3 Although that may be true, the text of the hymn still pertains to many Christian faiths including our own Catholicism. The words are inspired by the forty-sixth psalm "God, the protector of Zion", which includes:

"God is our refuge and our strength, an every-present help in our distress." and "The Lord of hosts is with us; our stronghold is the God of Jacob." 4

You may remember this tune from your youth in another way. In the 60s and 70s, the Lutheran Church developed an animated clay television series "Davey and Goliath", which used this hymn tune as its theme song.


Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
