The History of the Hymn Part 28

Lift High the Cross

Lyrics by George W. Kitchin and Rev. Michael R. Newbolt,
Music tune is CRUCIFER by Sydney Nicholson.



In our gospel reading for today, Jesus says to his disciples, “Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.”¹ The way of a follower of Christ is not meant to be an easy one, with the highest example to aspire to, a path of temptations to be ignored, and chances for grace that we need to avail ourselves of. A cross can be a physical challenge but also a spiritual one. Our hymn today reflects this and the willingness and joy with which we should take up our own particular crosses.

George Kitchin (1827 – 1912) was an Anglican clergyman. While serving as a dean of Winchester Cathedral in England he was commissioned in 1887 by the Society of the Propagation of the Gospel to write a service piece.² The hymn was shortened and adapted by the Anglican reverend Michael Newbolt (1874-1956), who also set it to a

tune by Sydney Nicholson (1875 – 1947).³ There is some suggestion that the inspiration for this song was drawn from the vision of the Emperor Constantine’s vision of a cross inscribed with the phrase “in hoc signo vinces”, or ‘in the sign of the cross you shall conquer’. Constantine did conquer his foes, became emperor and made Christianity the main religion in Rome.⁴ Perhaps we can draw our inspiration of this hymn as more a fight against Satan and the forces of evil and the victory of Christ over sin and death than a conquering of earthly foes.

As we sing this entrance hymn as the presider processes to the altar, let us see and revere the crucifix held high before him. May we be inspired anew by our Savior’s great sacrifice!

Saint Teresa of Calcutta

1910—1997

FEAST DAY: SEPTEMBER 5

Raised in a deeply Catholic family in Albania, Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu joined the Sisters of Loreto in 1928 and took the name Teresa. The community sent her to Kolkata, India, where she taught children for two decades. In 1946 Teresa heard God’s call to quench the thirst of Jesus by caring for the poorest of the poor. She left the Sisters of Loreto to rescue the sick and destitute in the slums of Kolkata -- one at a time. Many volunteers soon joined her and she formed them into her religious order, the Missionaries of Charity. Teresa’s manifest goodness and her unique media savvy attracted global attention, drawing many people to God. Many regard her as the greatest Catholic evangelist of the 20th century. She was beatified in 2003 and canonized in 2016.
