



A Coin: What is Your Coin Worth???



A young woman, of devout faith, who I spoke to recently, shared that she would very much like to be married and together with her husband, raise children who would give honor and glory to God. I thought this young woman spoke the truth about the noble and virtuous purpose for the sacrament of marriage. This lovely woman recalled for me today's gospel, where Jesus draws into sharp focus our worldly obligations, "Repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar" against our duties to God, "And give to God what belongs to God."

For most of us, our duties to society and to God will flow directly from our sense of the common good. The teachings of the Church are not an obstacle to living a life where society flourishes. The


flourishing of a good society begins with families who love, cherish and honor one another from conception to natural death. As we watch out for each other we make decisions in the world of economics, science and government that contribute to the real growth of her citizens.

Looking out for only yourself is not the way to render to God what belongs to God, nor is it the way to render proper tribute to a just society. We owe it to one another to form our consciences, according to Christian development of thought, and to know that the Church is an unlimited and sacred source of truth that really can meet the challenges of a world often devoid of a moral and religious compass. The Church knows how to stand with the poor, the marginalized and the downtrodden. She knows how to render care to families and the elderly and by so doing she improves society in many ways. The church also understands woundedness and how Christ alone can be the penetrating, healing balm.

At times, the Church has not always held up her principles, but when the Lord asks for a rendering, the Church seeks forgiveness and mercy. These lessons are the most powerful she teaches.

When Jesus holds up the "coin" of our life for us to look at, what will we see? Will He see an automaton paying taxes to society with no thought of the common good, or will the Lord see that joyous young woman or man looking forward to building a sacramental life of Christian faith and raising good citizens to help society flourish and grow.



Saint John Paul II

hen this popular pope died, crowds in St. Peter's Square chanted "santo subito" ("sainthood now"). The Vatican heard, and the sainthood cause for the jet setting pontiff who helped bring down European communism was put on the fast track; he was beatified in 2011. A strong admirer of St. Faustina and her dedication to Divine Mercy, John Paul II was canonized on Divine Mercy Sunday 2014 by Pope Francis.

A Pole and former actor shaped by World War II and the Cold War, Cardinal Karol Wojtyla of Krakow (John Paul II) was the first non-Italian pope in 455 years. In his 26-year pontificate, he evangelized on trips to 129 countries, upheld traditional church doctrine against dissent, connected with the world's youth, established World Youth Day, and named more than 450 new saints. He also modeled Christian values by forgiving his would-be assassin and living an increasingly frail old age in public.

John Paul II established Divine Mercy Sunday as the Second Sunday of Easter for the Church in April 2000, though the feast had already been celebrated in Poland for many years. In that first Divine Mercy Sunday Mass, John Paul II said it was Jesus' love and mercy that must inspire all of humanity:





It is this love which must inspire humanity today, if it is to face the crisis of the meaning of life, the challenges of the most diverse needs and, especially, the duty to defend the dignity of every human person. Thus the message of divine mercy is also implicitly a message about the value of every human being. Each person is precious in God's eyes; Christ gave his life for each one; to everyone the Father gives his Spirit and offers intimacy.

Saints Simon and Jude

isted among the Twelve Apostles in the New Testament, Simon is "the Canaanite" to Matthew and Mark and "the Zealot" to Luke; Jude is "Thaddeus" to Matthew and Mark, "Judas of James" to Luke, and "Judas, not Iscariot" to John. After Pentecost, they disappear. However, according to Eastern tradition, Simon died peacefully in Edessa, while Western tradition has him evangelizing in Egypt, then teaming up with Jude, who had been in Mesopotamia, on a mission to Persia, where they were martyred on the same day. Simon is the patron saint of tanners and lumberjacks; Jude is the patron of desperate causes, possibly because early Christians would pray to him, with a name evoking Judas Iscariot, only when all else failed.
