

his laywoman and foundress, born a Roman aristocrat, married Lorenzo Ponziano when she was 13; they had several children. In 1409, their palazzo was pillaged by Neapolitan soldiers and Lorenzo was exiled for five years, returning home a broken man. He died in 1436. Frances, known for her great charity during epidemics and civil war, organized a ladies society dedicated to self-denial and good works. It became the Oblates of Tor de Specchi, which she directed for her last four years. She is the patron saint of motorists, perhaps because she was guarded for 23 years by an archangel visible only to her. Her last words were: "The angel has finished his work. He is beckoning me to follow."

# STATIONS OF THE CROSS SEVEN LAST WORDS

On all of the Friday evenings of Lent at Immaculate Conception, beginning at 7pm, please join us for a reflection on one of the Seven Last Words of Christ followed by the Stations of the Cross. #### ABSTINENCE AND FASTING

Catholics over 14 years of age are bound to the obligation of abstinence. Abstinence is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays in Lent. On days of abstinence, meat may not be used.

Catholics over 18 years of age and up to 59 years are bound to the obligation of fasting. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. On these days, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to ones needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed.



#### **EL SALVADOR**

El Salvador, the smallest and most densely populated country in Central America, has been hard hit by years of violence, climate change, deforestation, and natural disasters. Sandra, her husband Santos and their children are among the numerous El Salvadorans who have benefited from your Rice Bowl contributions. When unpredictable weather in their

native region of Morazan made farming difficult, they participated in a CRS-sponsored project which taught them how to raise chickens to provide them with income stability. Throughout El Salvador, CRS has partnered with locals to improve farming systems and futures.

For the El Salvadoran youth, CRS offers concrete programs presenting solutions to their three main problems of unemployment, violence, and migration. CRS's youth violence prevention programs promote peace, and its skill-building workshops help marginalized youth to become actively employed. Always looking toward the larger picture, CRS is currently involved in reintroducing cacao crops to El Salvador with the aim of eventually raising income levels through the sale of high-quality chocolate, and CRS is leading reforestation efforts which will mitigate the effects of natural disasters.
