#### The feast day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel is celebrated on July 16.

This feast commemorates the Virgin Mary's role as a spiritual guide and protector, particularly within



the Carmelite Order. It is linked to the tradition that Mary appeared to St. Simon Stock in 1251, presenting him with the Brown Scapular and promising her protection to those who wear it. The feast is named after Mount Carmel, a mountain in Israel where the prophet Elijah famously challenged the prophets of Baal, and where the Carmelite Order originated. The Brown Scapular is a central symbol of devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel, as a sign of Mary's protection and a pledge of her intercession.


