Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In previous decades there was an annual pre-Christmas thrill for generations of children, particularly those of us within a rural setting. The arrival of the Sears Wish Book was an occasion of great joy. Many hours were spent pouring over its pages and formulating a wish list, mental or otherwise, of what to ask Santa to bring.

In today's Gospel Jesus encourages us to ask, to search, to knock. In turn we are assured that we will receive, we will find and we will have the way opened to us. That said, this exhortation to have confidence in prayer concludes with an expectation of what - or rather who - ought to be asking for : the Person of the Holy Spirit! Carlo Acutis Day – New Date

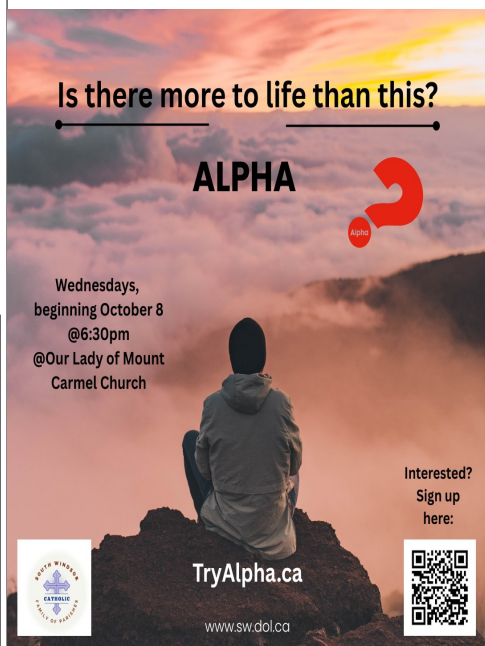

In 2013, Bishop Fabbro reminded priests of a 1998 directive from Bishop Sherlock that bans all activities related to the BNP Movement (Banal Na Pag-aaral, or Holy Studies Group) within the Diocese of London. The movement, which originated in the Philippines, has been found to contain elements contrary to Catholic teaching. It has recently come to our attention that BNP is attempting to restart retreats in the Windsor-Essex deanery. As a reminder:

BNP activities are not permitted in any diocesan or affiliated facility (e.g., schools, hospitals, retreat centres).

Clergy may not participate in any BNP-sponsored events, including sacramental celebrations.

Your vigilance in upholding this directive is appreciated.
