Second Scrutiny

This Sunday's readings reveal a God who sees differently than we do. While we often focus on appearances, failures, or limitations, the Lord looks directly into the heart with the desire to heal and restore. In the Gospel, the man born blind becomes a living image of every disciple: unable to save himself, yet sought out by Christ, touched, healed, and gradually brought into the fullness of faith.

The Second Scrutiny invites our Elect—and all of us—to confront the blindness that keeps us from God: the habits we excuse, the darkness we tolerate, the truths we avoid. St Paul's call rings out clearly: "Awake, O sleeper, and Christ will shine on you."

As we pray over the Elect today, we ask the Lord to free them from the power of sin and to awaken in all of us a deeper desire for His light. Their journey toward Baptism is meant to stir our own conversion, so that together we may see with the eyes of Christ and walk as children of the light.



Lives in the village of Piquiá de Baixo in Brazil began being disrupted in the 1980s, with the arrival of several polluting industries in their backyard. The villagers formed an association to defend their rights. Flavia's father started the fight, and she picked up the torch.

Last year, after a 20year struggle, 312 families affected by industrial pollution moved to the new, cleaner, safer village of Piquiá da Conquista. The support of Development and Peace — Caritas Canada's partner, *Justiça nos Trilhos (JnT)*, made this relocation possible for 1,300 people.


