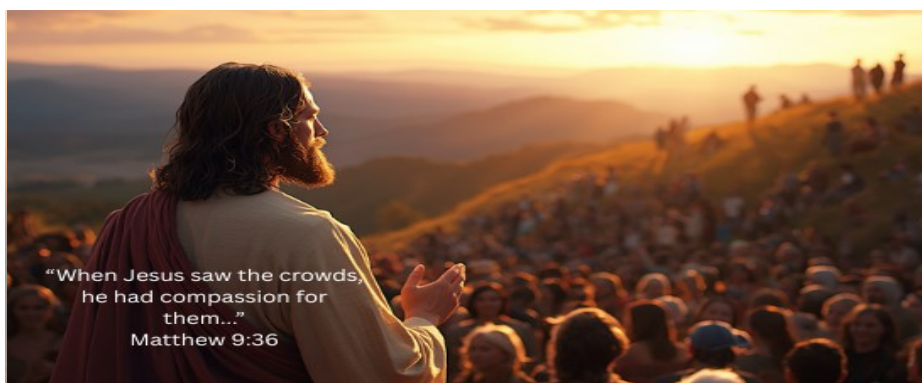

Reflection – Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

"You yourselves have seen what I did... how I bore you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself" (Ex 19). As Israel stands at the foot of Sinai, God reminds them that covenant always begins with grace. Before mission comes mercy. Before responsibility comes rescue. Paul echoes this in Romans: "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." We are not sent because we are strong, but because we have been loved. The Psalm invites us to respond with joyful service: "Know that the Lord is God... we are his people." Everything begins with belonging.

In the Gospel, Jesus looks at the crowds with deep compassion—not irritation, not frustration, but a shepherd's heart moved by their exhaustion. From that compassion, He calls and sends the Twelve. Mission flows from mercy. This past week, as your Pastoral Team gathered for planning, we stood in that same movement: remembering who God has been for us, listening for His vision, and discerning how to form intentional disciples in our Family of Parishes. Our work is not simply administrative; it is a participation in Christ's own shepherding gaze upon His people.

As we look ahead to the upcoming Staff Retreat, we ask the Lord to renew in us the heart of the Good Shepherd. We want our vision to be His vision, our mission to be His mission, our planning to be rooted in His compassion. Like the apostles, we are sent to "cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse the lepers, cast out demons"—to push back everything that diminishes human dignity and obscures the Gospel. Please pray for us as a staff, and pray for our whole Family of Parishes, that we may be faithful to the covenant love that has claimed us and courageous in the mission Christ entrusts to us.
