Reflection – Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's readings, we meet the generous woman of Sunem, who makes room in her home for the prophet Elisha—and discovers that when we create space for God, God fills that space with new life. Jesus deepens this truth in the Gospel: true discipleship means placing Him first, even above the good and holy loves of family, comfort, and routine. When Christ is at the centre, everything else finds its proper place.

Yet Jesus also reminds us that discipleship is lived not only in great sacrifices but in small, hidden acts of love: a welcome, a kind word, even a simple cup of cold water offered in His name. Nothing done for Christ is ever lost. As we continue our journey through Ordinary Time, may we renew our desire to make room for the Lord and to let our daily acts—large or small—become signs of His presence in the world.

Reflection – Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Saint Paul reminds us today that the Christian life is marked by a strange paradox: God's power is made perfect not in our strength, but in our weakness. Paul does not hide his "thorn in the flesh"; instead, he discovers that grace is most visible precisely where he is least capable. This is not an invitation to glorify struggle, but to recognize that Christ meets us most deeply when we stop pretending we can save ourselves. The Psalm echoes this confidence: "The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." Our limitations are not obstacles to God—they are openings.

In the Gospel, Jesus praises the Father for revealing the mysteries of the Kingdom not to the self-assured, but to the humble and the small. The wisdom of God is received not through mastery, but through trust. As a parish community, this is good news. We do not need to be perfect to be disciples; we need to be open. Wherever we feel tired, uncertain, or stretched thin, Christ invites us to come to Him and find rest—not escape, but the deep rest that restores courage and renews mission. May this week be a time of letting go of burdens we were never meant to carry alone, and rediscovering the gentle strength of the One who walks with us.

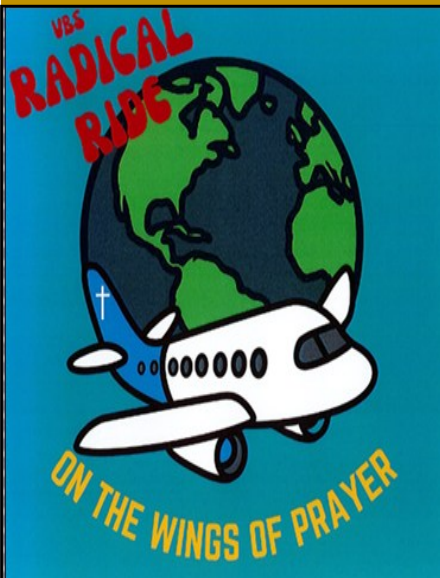
