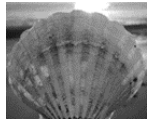


## Zoom Weekly Faith Sharing with Annette

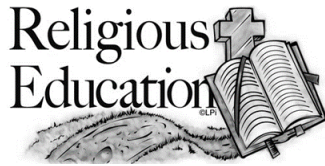
