- V. Commission Reports
 - A. Worship & Prayer Commission Written report submitted. (Cindy Holliday)

- A. Deacon (Deacon Jeff)

- Sustainability of our Parish financially, we are not meeting our expenses.
- The current outstanding balance on the church hall is now \$192, 000.
- The loan with the bank has been extended and locked in at a lower interest rate.
- The offertory giving is up since the baskets are back at Mass.
- The new budget will be finalized in June.
- D. Latino Ministry Representative (No one present)
 - Brenda reported that they are very excited that there will be a Spanish speaking priest.
- E. Principal of Prince of Peace School Written report submitted (Andrew Bradley)
 - Bishop Zinkula visited the school at the end of March.
 - Father Appel and Father Lamansky also visited the school. Father Lamansky will be the school Chaplain and will be on campus 2-3 days a week. They both would like to team teach the Jr/Sr Theology class.
 - Seniors of Prince of Peace School attended the Baccalaureate Mass at Sacred Heart Chapel on Wednesday, May 18th. All seniors of the parish will be honored at the 8:00am Mass on May 22nd. The Prince of Peace graduation ceremony is Sunday, May 22nd, at 2:00pm in the church.
 - Prince of Peace school is in the process of doing a facilities audit. Estes will be coming in to assess the school facilities at a discounted rate.
 - They are trying to hire people to fill open positions at the school. Encourage anyone who might be interested in teaching at Prince of Peace to apply.
 - New board members are needed at Prince of Peace. Applications are available on the school website.

 - They are anticipating to meet in person this summer.
