  - D. Stewardship Annual Stewardship renewal process
    - i. A copy of the new ministry catalog was distributed. Please read and proof this catalog.
      - ii. The Annual Diocesan Appeal from last year pledged about \$8000 more than our goal. The paid portion of this so far is about \$5000 more than our goal. Any excess over the goal is returned to the parish. Last year's goal was \$89,667 and this year the goal will be \$84,665.
    - iii. Upon This Rock Campaign \$781,000 has been pledged by our parish, \$237,000 has been paid. 20% of the \$237,000 becomes the property of the parish. The plan is to set aside 12 months of the mortgage payment and then the balance would be applied to the mortgage balance. Our participation rate for the parish was around 44%, which is above the average of the diocese.
