- DO NOT throw away documentation accumulated over the years.
- Always keep a valid passport with you.
- Make sure to have a valid birth certificate along with an English translation.
- Make sure to keep and maintain any other type of identification (from work, school, or government).
- Complete your taxes every year.
- Study English.
- Participate in your community.
- Avoid any problems with law enforcement officials.
- DO NOT consult with a Public Notary for your immigration issues.

Please Beware of Immigration Scams

TIPS TO REMEMBER

- DO get immigration information from official government websites. Web addresses for federal government agencies include ".gov" not ".com."
- DO get a receipt when you pay someone to help you complete your immigration forms.
- DO verify that the person giving you legal advice and representing you before USCIS is an attorney or BIA-accredited representative.
- DO NOT pay for blank USCIS forms. All USCIS forms are free and available at www.uscis.gov or at your local USCIS office.
- DO NOT sign forms that contain incorrect information. Be sure that all information is true and correct before signing them.
- DO NOT sign documents that you cannot understand. Before you sign any immigration forms, read them carefully and be sure you understand them.

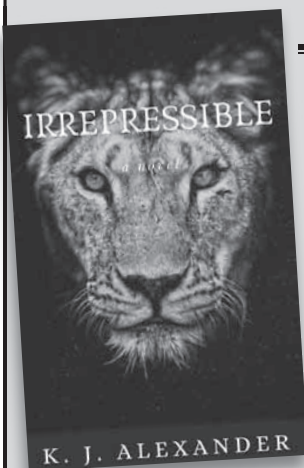
