- Complete your taxes every year.
- Study English.
- · Participate in your community.
- Avoid any problems with law enforcement officials.
- DO NOT consult with a Public Notary for your immigration issues.



#### Please Beware of Immigration Scams

#### TIPS TO REMEMBER

- DO get immigration information from official government websites. Web addresses for federal government agencies include ".gov" not ".com."
- DO get a receipt when you pay someone to help you complete your immigration forms.
- DO verify that the person giving you legal advice and representing you before USCIS is an attorney or BIA-accredited representative.
- DO NOT pay for blank USCIS forms.
   All USCIS forms are free and available at <a href="https://www.uscis.gov">www.uscis.gov</a> or at your local USCIS office.
- DO NOT sign forms that contain incorrect information. Be sure that all information is true and correct before singing them.
- DO NOT sign documents that you cannot understand. Before you sign any immigration forms, read them carefully and be sure you understand them.


