"Tell Him a Welcome"

Carmelites love Christmas! We love Easter, of course, and we thrill at the thought of the Resurrection, but Christmas has a special place in our hearts. We are utterly delighted that God was born as a baby, that He became human because it is our humanity that He took, and He will have it forevermore! Jesus is God and now He is also made of the same stuff as we are: He has a human soul and body, and He can never ever separate Himself from us!

We love that we share humanity with Him, and though Carmel is an austere place, with a plain building and simple fare, at Christmas we decorate for all we are worth! We hang decorations on anything that will hold them, we sing Christmas carols as part of our prayer time, we have a posada procession throughout the whole monastery, and we have about six different nativity sets besides the crib set up in our chapel.

The Infant in the crib is a special delight for us, and there is a story that St. John of the Cross, who is often portrayed as a solemn killjoy of a saint, once picked up the Infant from the crib and danced around the room with him. We all want to do that every day of our life: to dance through time holding God in our arms and in our hearts!
