



Today we'll focus on the work-center that was the focus of our Lenten Almsgiving in 2023.

We processed into Consolacion with the local Ordinary,
Bishop Walter Guillen. Bishop Walter celebrated a beautiful Mass,
blessing and ribbon cutting service for the community.

The work-center still has some work pending, but the sewing
workshop and guitar program are ready for classes. We still
have some equipment to source and install on the culinary side
and work to do on the restroom facilities. There are an incredible
135 students signed up for sewing, cooking and guitar lessons.
They represent 8 of the 10 neighboring villages and the sign-ups
were capped for now to ensure the quality of programming.








Consolacion is becoming a center of hope and new life for this entire remote mountain area.


ATTENTION MEN OF ST. PIUS X PARISH! Prayer, Formation, and Fraternity for Men






