This is the last of the previews Deacon Chris put together leading up to this weekend's presentation this Sunday after the 10am Mass.

This story represents 5 years of work. A fungal blight devastated much of the coffee throughout the countryside surrounding Consolacion in the years leading up to 2019. Coffee producers were devastated. Union de Amor sponsored a trip for some community leaders to travel across Honduras to an area bordering Nicaragua to source seeds of a blight-resistant, high quality, coffee. They were mentored by some coffee experts and returned to Consolacion with the seeds.

The seeds were planted, nurtured alongside the community Chapel until they were mature enough to transplant into the coffee fields ("Fincas"). Over 100,000 seedlings were shared among the coffee producers and transplanted in their fincas. This year was the first year the new plants were mature enough to produce fruit for a harvest.

One current finca owner (Tito, age 27) was among those who went to get the seeds. He was also mentored and returned to Consolacion ready to focus on revitalizing his finca and starting a hardware store which was recommended by the mentor because coffee as a business is seasonal and subject to the whims of the weather. Tito was wrestling with the decision to try to go to the United States with his brother prior to his time with the mentor and his decision to build something in Honduras.

Come on Sunday and learn how Tito's story unfolded! It is a tremendous example of how Consolacion is becoming a center of hope and new life for this entire remote mountain area. On Sunday, I'll tell the rest of this beautiful story and also share what this year's almsgiving will help accomplish next.




