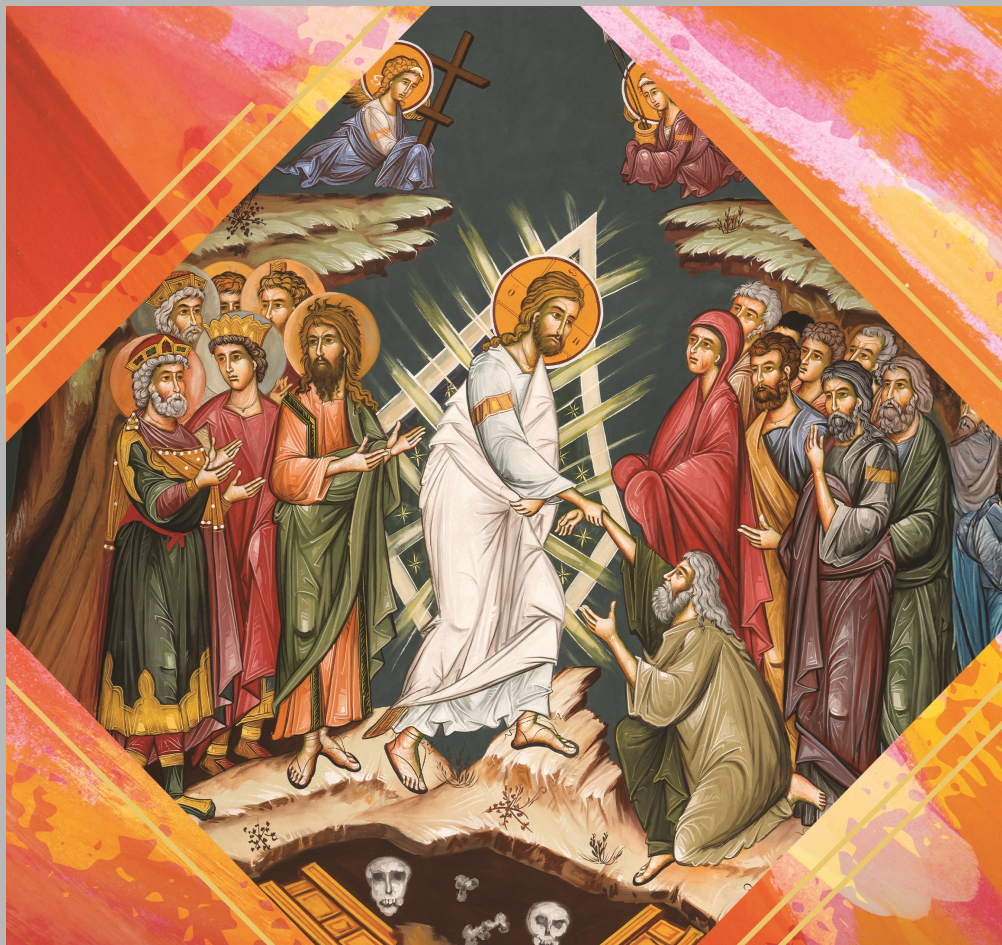

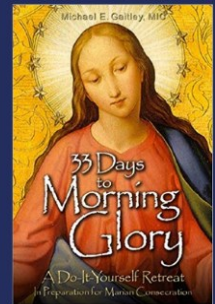
## Marian Consecration


