Dear Family,

Pastor's Corner

First of all, I want you to know how thrilled I was by the turnout for our joint parish picnic! It warmed my heart to see our parishioners at both parishes coming together to celebrate and enjoy life just because we can! Thanks to all who came and especially those who helped make it a success!

As you are probably aware, **October is Respect Life**Month, a time where we call to mind the great dignity of the human person, a dignity which is rooted in the fact that we are made and likeness and created to share in the very life of God. Let's reflect

in God's image and likeness and created to share in the very life of God. Let's reflect on the truth that each and every human person is a "manifestation of God in the world, a sign of his presence, a trace of his glory" (Evangelium Vitae).

There are so many attacks on this innate dignity of the human person, from poverty to malnutrition to human trafficking. I would like to briefly draw attention to two of these attacks, which I feel are particularly relevant:

Domestic violence— which is when a spouse seeks to maintain power and control over the other, often through physical or sexual violence as well as through emotional abuses such as financial control and isolation. Violence is never justified in any form, whether physical, sexual, psychological or verbal and is always sinful. The Bible and Church teachings must never be used to justify this behavior (although it often is) and indeed the Church has always taught that spouses are equals in dignity. Recognizing the sacredness of Marriage, it is necessary still to say that it is never the requirement of the Catholic Church that any spouse remain in an abusive and dangerous living

Abortion—Foremost among all of these threats is attacks on the weakest and most vulnerable people; children in their mother's wombs and those approaching the end of their lives. The Catholic bishops emphasize that the threat of abortion continues to be our preeminent priority because it directly attacks life, it takes place within the sanctuary of the family, and because of the sheer numbers of lives it destroys. This preeminent priority should hold the greatest weight when deciding who to vote for.

This October let's ask ourselves: Do I support and advocate for laws and policies that protect and defend human life? Do I help pregnant and parenting mothers in need? Am I ready to support a loved one nearing death?


