Dear Family,

Here is your interesting fact about St. Stanislaus for the week! Note, it (and all of my other fun facts about him) are from a book I have on his life that was published back in the late 1800s. There will be much more next week about him!

St. Stanislaus had a deep devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He would often say with a touching simplicity and trust: My Dear Mother, I have need of you in this matter." He also never began any new action without seeking his heavenly Mother's blessing by turning himself in the direction in which he knew there to be some image of her and his favorite conversations were about Mary's virtues.

I want to share a note on the upcoming celebrations in our Liturgical Calendar, especially since they are beautiful expressions of our belief in the Communion of Saints, which sees the Church as a family and not just a random, disconnected assortment of people in a building.

"We believe in the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are being purified, and the blessed in heaven, all together forming one Church; and we believe that in this communion, the merciful love of God and his saints is always [attentive] to our prayers" (CCC, 962).

On **November 1**st, we celebrate **All Saints' Day**, which is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year, but which is still a day we should celebrate by going to Mass if we can, by praying to our favorite saints, and by having a festive meal together as a family. All Saints' Day is a day we also honor all of those many unknown men and women who victoriously reign with Christ in Heaven, even though they are not officially canonized saints. Your relatives who have died may already be in the ranks of the triumphant in heaven, especially if they led holy lives while here on Earth. I am planning on displaying our collection of relics in front of the altar for veneration. Relics (part of a saint, such as bone or hair)) make holiness more tangible for us and help us to realize that the saints were men and women like you and me who chose to put Christ first in the life and to lay down their lives for Him. We too can follow in their footsteps, and they are close to us and want to help us on our pilgrimage to heaven.

On November 2nd, we celebrate All Souls' day, a day that we pray for all those who have died (the faithful departed) and are not yet in heaven, but are instead in purgatory, being purified of the stain of sin that still clung to them when they died. This celebration is a day to pray for them, that they might quickly be cleansed of their sin and join the ranks of the saints in heaven. The celebration of Mass is the highest means the Church can provide for charity for the dead, but we can also relieve their sufferings through our prayers and penances. We can particularly help the Poor Souls by doing acts and prayers that have indulgences attached to them.

A plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is granted to the faithful who,

- ~ on any and each day from November 1 to 8, devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the departed;
- ~ on All Souls' Day, devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed.
