#### Dear Family,

We have a new IC secretary – Jean Trausch! Many of you already know Jean since she has been the area for quite a while and is a faithful parishioner of Immaculate Conception parish. Please give her a warm welcome to her new role on staff at IC when you see her!

This week, I wanted to offer some instruction regarding Mass intentions. First, you may not know that each pastor is bound by Canon law to offer up one Mass each Sunday and holy day of obligation for his parishioners. This "pro populo" (for the people/parishioners) Mass is a powerful reminder to the priest that he must never fail to intentionally intercede for his flock. It is also a reminder to his parishioners that they can count on their pastor's spiritual aid and protection in their personal lives and that he is battling for their souls. While it is most common to have Mass offered up for a deceased loved one since they can no longer merit anything by their own efforts and are dependent on us for aid, it is also appropriate to have Mass offered up in thanksgiving for something, for a living person (such as on the occasion of their birthday), or for a living person who might be sick or struggling in some other way. Also, the person for whom Mass is being offered need not be Catholic or even Christian.

One's personal Mass intention does not conflict with the public Mass intention offered up by the priest nor does it somehow diminish the power and efficacy of the sacrifice of the Mass. In fact, each of us should approach Mass with a private intention in mind that we can spiritually place upon the altar. This is an ancient practice and St. Ambrose (d. 397) is one of many saints that attest to it: "We have loved them during life; let us not abandon them in death, until we have conducted them by our prayers into the house of the Lord." The priest has several intentions in mind at each Mass: Celebrating Mass validly and reverently for the good of the whole Church and the glory of almighty God; for the intention of the one who made an offering; for his own personal intentions. It is permissible for a priest to have up to two Masses a week which include more than one public intention, and these are known as collective Mass intentions. Again, given that the Mass is the most perfect form of prayer and is infinitely meritorious, no matter how many private or public intentions there are, the power of the Mass is not diminished nor are intentions "shortchanged." The offering for a Mass intention is generally \$10 and can be arranged at the church office with Kathi Rewerts (SS) or Jean Trausch (IC). This offering is not simony as nothing is being sold, but rather the offering is freely given (not required, and less can be given) and allows the giver an opportunity to make a sacrifice for the intention, which in turn brings blessings upon that person. The main intention of the Mass need not be mentioned out loud during Mass in order for the power of the Mass to be applied to it. It is my custom to try and announce it to bring comfort and peace to the one offering the intention but rest assured that the Mass is applied to the intention one way or the other. To conclude, I want to share a quote from Pope Leo XIII's encyclical "Mirae caritatis" (1902) which describes the infinite graces at the Sacrifice of the Mass that benefi

"The grace of mutual love among the living, strengthened and increased by the sacrament of the Eucharist, flows, especially by virtue of the Sacrifice [of the Mass], to all who belong to the communion of saints. For the communion of saints is simply ...the mutual sharing of help, atonement, prayers and benefits among the faithful, those already in the heavenly fatherland, those consigned to the purifying fire, and those still making their pilgrim way here on earth. These all form one city, whose head is Christ, and whose vital principle is love. Faith teaches that although the august Sacrifice can be offered to God alone, it can nevertheless be celebrated in honor of the saints now reigning in Heaven with God, who has crowned them, to obtain their intercession for us, and also, according to apostolic tradition, to wash away the stains of those brethren who died in the Lord but without yet being wholly purified."
