RECTOR'S CORNER

April 23, 2023 Growing Pains & Parking Adjustments

Dear Friends in Christ:
Anh chị em thân mến trong Chúa Kitô:
Estimados Amigos y Amigas en Cristo:

Progress continues to be made on the asbestos abatement of the old property and demolition is set to begin very shortly—hopefully within the next two weeks. The good news is that will get us one step closer to our expanded parking capabilities. The bad news is that it will require some growing pains in the short-term. We cannot avoid the growing pains, but we can work around them.

Therefore, I am sharing this with you today so that you may be prepared as soon as the date comes that the parking lot across the street from the Co-Cathedral becomes unavailable or limited, whenever that may be. Beginning now and for the remainder of 2023 (until project completion), please keep the following in mind when you visit the Co-Cathedral of the Sacred Heart:


- Parking may or may not be available across the street
- Parking will continue to be available at Cathedral Centre
- The chancery overflow parking lot (directly behind the Co-Cathedral), which is always open on weekends and is open throughout the week during Lent, will be available for Co-Cathedral parking seven days a week throughout this process
- We have worked with Amegy Bank to extend the hours when garage parking is available during this time. The garage will be accessible for no charge to Co-Cathedral visitors from 1:30 PM to 7:00 PM on Saturdays and from 6:30 AM to 7:30 PM on Sundays. We will continue to work with Amegy Bank for additional parking coverage when it is possible for events outside of these weekend windows. Amegy Bank always has their own security on hand when their parking garage is in use.
- Street and metered parking is still accessible at the discretion and expense of the one parking.

During the 11 AM Sunday Mass, many of you are already used to parking in the Amegy Garage. For other Mass times, including daily Masses, there has been no need to park anywhere other than in the lot across the street. While this means that some may experience some disruption to their normal routines, we are working to ensure that our visitors always have a way to come to us when needed. Please bear with our mess and remember that the payoff will be worth it when the work is complete!

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all our trust in you! Amen!


PARISH LIFE


